STRUCTURE OF THE SOCIETY:

The By-laws of the Society provide for membership of the Society to be composed of the Archbishop, the Vicar General, the Episcopal Vicar of Education, the pastor of every parish with a school, the Archbishop's representative of every regional school, one elected lay member from each parish with a school, and one elected lay member from each regional school.

The Board of Directors of the Society consists of the Archbishop who is ex-officio the President, the Vicar General, the Episcopal Vicar of Education and eight elected directors (five lay members and three priests). The eight elected directors are elected by members of the Society at the Annual General Meeting.

The Board of Directors appoints the officers (except the President who is ex-officio the Archbishop). These officers are President, Vice-President, Secretary and Treasurer.

Under Section 14 of the By-laws it is stated that the members of the Society shall comprise an Advisory Board, and may be called upon to report and form committees for the purpose of the better administration of the Society.
