



GOVERNANCE

EDUCATION COMMITTEE - ADDITIONAL VOTING MEMBERS 105

Rationale

When a delegate to the Society from an education committee is elected to the Board of Directors his/her effectiveness on the Education Committee may be diminished.

Policy

Education Committees may be increased by one (1) voting members if their delegate is elected to the Board of Directors.

Procedure

- 1.0** In the event that the Parish Education Committee's delegate to the Society is elected to the Board of Directors at the Annual General Meeting, the pastor may appoint, annually, an additional voting member to the parish education committee, for as long as that parish representative serves on the Board of Directors.
- 1.1** In the event that the regional high school education committee's delegate to the Society is elected to the Board of Directors at the Annual Meeting, the pastor of the parish the member represents may appoint, annually, an additional voting member to the regional committee, for as long as the regional education committee representative serves on the Board of Directors.
- 1.2** Except for the circumstances described in 1.0 and 1.1, no additional member to an education committee may be elected or appointed without the written approval of the Board of Directors.
