ROLE OF THE EDUCATION COMMITTEE VICE CHAIRPERSON 115

Rationale

The role of the Vice-Chairperson in the parish or regional education committee is critical to the successful functioning of the Education Committee and ultimately to the successful functioning of the school.

Policy

The Vice-Chairperson will take over the tasks of the chairperson and become acting chairperson during the chairperson's absence. See Policy 114 for chairperson's tasks.

Procedure

The Vice-Chairperson is elected to fulfill the following responsibilities:

1. To be the Society delegate/representative if the local committee decides.
2. To carry on any other duties as assigned by the local Parish Education Committee.
